# Annual Oxford Animal Ethics Summer School Terms and Conditions

### 1. Payments

All bookings must be made prior to the Summer School and must be paid in full to guarantee registration. Once payment has been received, an email confirmation and a receipted invoice will be sent. All payments need to be received at least 4 weeks before the Summer School.

# 2. Cancellations

Cancellation charges apply as follows:

8 weeks or more prior to start of event: 10% of the delegate fee

4 to 8 weeks prior to start of event: 50% of the delegate fee

4 weeks or less prior to start of event: 100% of the delegate fee

All cancellations must be received in writing.

#### 3. Access Requirements

Delegates should advise of any special access requirements at the time of booking.

#### 4. Summer School Information

Information on how to check in for the Summer School will be sent to registered delegates by email at least seven days prior to the event. Any delegate not receiving the registration information should contact us by email: depdirector@oxfordanimalethics.com

#### 5. Alterations to Programme - Cancellation/Postponement of Event

1. Oxford Centre for Animal Ethics (OCAE) reserves the right to make alterations to the Summer School programme, venue and timings.

2. In the unlikely event of the programme being cancelled by OCAE, a full refund will be made. Liability will be limited to the amount of the fee paid by the delegate.

3. In the event of it being found necessary, for whatever reason, that the conference is being postponed or the dates being changed, the organisers shall not be liable for any expenditure, damage or loss incurred by the delegate.

4. If by re-arrangement or postponement the event can take place, the booking between the delegate and the organisers shall remain in force and will be subject to the cancellation schedule above.

Delegates who do not wish to be included on this list should advise at the time of booking, or indicate on the booking form if they do not wish for their email to be shared.

- Your name, mailing address and email is shared with our accountants, both Critchley's and our online accountancy platform Xero. This is only used for the purpose of invoicing you for the Summer School.
- Your email and name is shared with our email system Mail Chimp. We use your email address to send you both information shared with our general mailing list (e.g. newsletters and promotional materials), and specific emails about the Summer School.
- Your name, dietary information, and any accessibility requirements are shared with Merton College, University of Oxford, in order to facilitate your booking at the Summer School.
- We collect your phone number. This is only to contact you in case of an emergency or cancellation of the Summer School. We do not share your phone number with anyone.
- All information is stored on the Centre's computers before, during and after the Summer School. If after the Summer School you no longer wish us to retain your information, please email <u>depdirector@oxfordanimalethics.com</u> and we will remove all your data from our lists.
